# A Message from Your Community Foundation

The Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation's Board of Trustees, staff and many volunteers are excited to present The Legacy, an annual magazine highlighting accomplishments from the last year in building endowments, grantmaking, and community leadership. This publication celebrates our growth as an organization dedicated to the stewardship of resources entrusted to us by donors in our community. Because of the

support of 53 generous sponsors (featured on the back cover), we are able to share stories of local philanthropy and community impact in publications like this that reach thousands throughout Isabella County and beyond.

The Legacy includes great photos and stories about

those who have started permanent endowment funds within the Community Foundation, and the organizations and individuals who have benefitted from grant awards. Ten new funds were established over the last year, named to memorialize loved ones and in honor of families and local companies. MPACF now holds 287 endowment funds and 1,432 individual gifts were made to these funds in 2017—in amounts ranging from five dollars to thousands of dollars—further building community capital to meet the needs of future generations.

The Community Foundation is not tied to a single social cause or mission. Instead, we are responsible for making the right investments, in the right organizations, at the right times. We

have committed volunteers with broad expertise who serve our donors and our nonprofit partners by matching available resources to projects and programs addressing current community needs. In 2017, these volunteers helped to award 216 grants. So far in 2018, 98 scholarships have been awarded. Since our inception in 1990, the Community Foundation has awarded nearly \$6.3 million in grants to schools, local governments and charities. That's \$6.3 million granted while maintaining the value of every endowed gift ever given to the Foundation!

We continue our focus on community leadership, establishing a special project fund to collect charitable contributions to purchase the property at 1114 West High Street in Mt. Pleasant to house local nonprofit organizations. Several partner agencies, including four tenant organizations, have worked hard to develop what has come to be known as the Strickler Center. Together, we seek to address the most pressing needs of the large population of citizens in Isabella County living in or near poverty. Agencies housed in the Strickler Center provide food, clothing, personal care items, and emergency shelter during the coldest months of the year. Over time, these organizations and other community partners will develop and implement a Jobs Academy to have a greater, long-term impact—reducing overall poverty levels in Isabella County.

We hope, as you flip through the pages of The Legacy, you are inspired to invest in people and places through the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation. Together, we will continue to enhance the quality of life for all citizens of Isabella County, now and for generations to come.






### INVESTMENT RETURNS





# Youth Advisory Committee



For twenty-six years, the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) of the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation has included a group of committed students from Isabella County schools who focus on grantmaking, volunteering, and fundraising. While performing these tasks, YAC members learn about team building, leadership, responsibility, and philanthropy.

YAC student leaders spend time positively influencing their community while learning about service and civic engagement. Once a month, the YAC meets to review grant applications, participate in leadership training, plan community service projects, and fundraisers. Their fundraising efforts benefit the endowed Kellogg Youth Fund. The YAC wants to help this fund grow so that they are able to award more grants to charitable organizations, schools, and units of government that benefit the youth of Isabella County.

In June, some YAC members attended the Youth Grantmakers Summer Leadership Conference at Central Michigan University where youth from around the state gathered to collaborate and grow as individuals, and were encouraged to take what they learned and put it to use throughout





the upcoming academic year. The current YAC president represents the youth at the Foundation's Grant Review and Board of Trustees meetings. YAC recently welcomed a new youth member, and recognized a graduating senior during their annual meeting.

The YAC is most interested in funding efforts that address the needs of youth through personal development programs, after-school recreation/social activities, job development opportunities, community youth organizations, and volunteer programs. They determine their grantmaking decisions, in part, with the help of their

Youth Needs assessment. This is a survey given to the 8th and 10th graders of Isabella County every three years, and is administered by the YAC through a partnership with area schools. The 2017 survey identified the most important issues facing youth today as follows: 1) bullying, 2) stress/school pressure, 3) depression/suicide/loss, 4) alcohol and drug abuse, and 5) self-esteem/respect for yourself and others. 

## *Strickler Nonprofit Center*

Isabella County is home to 70,698 people, making up 24,246 households. Twenty-five percent of households live below the Federal Poverty Level (defined as \$11,770 for a single adult and \$24,250 for a family of four). Another twenty-five percent of households live below the ALICE threshold. ALICE is an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed — households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the County. This means that 50% of all households in Isabella County are struggling to afford basic needs. Through collaboration, at least six local charitable organizations are working to serve those needs more effectively.

What started as a dream three years ago has become reality at 1114 West High Street in Mt. Pleasant. Occupied since September 2017 under a lease-to-purchase agreement between Victory Christian Church and United Way of Gratiot and Isabella County, a nonprofit center has developed. The Center offers quality space with increased efficiencies for organizations striving to support

those living in poverty in Isabella County. Community Compassion Network, Isabella County Restoration House, Clothing INC, and The Care Store provide critical services - food, shelter, clothing, and personal care items. Long term, these partners and others are committed to reducing overall poverty levels in Isabella County.

A project fund was established at the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation to collect funds to purchase the property and make the Center permanent. In April 2018, the Foundation announced that Jan Strickler had made a lead gift to name the Center in memory of her husband, Bill. During the Foundation's breakfast in September, the fundraising team announced the facility would be named for both Bill and Jan. As of September 24, 2018, nearly \$900,000 of the \$1 million goal had been raised by the collaborative.

The William and Janet Strickler Nonprofit Center fosters strong collaboration among key social






service agencies by developing a shared physical space and cooperative interactions to do two things. First, the organizations within the Center will work to address the most pressing needs of a large population of citizens in Isabella County living in or near poverty. Second, the Center will create synergies to help reduce the level of poverty in Isabella County over time. The Strickler Center will strive to move their guests from needing the services provided to supporting themselves. A "Jobs Academy" will provide formal education/training and real-world professional skills.



A separate legal entity will be formed by the local charitable partners to purchase the new community asset in 2019. Community members are encouraged to help raise the remaining funds needed by #GivingTuesday, a national day of charitable giving planned for November 27, 2018. ## *Brattin Memorial Art Fund*

The difficult technique is a wipeout-style of underpainting that allows you to broadly push and pull values with a thin layer of paint that is free of sharp edges and ridges. After her death in 2006, her husband, Chester Rose, chose to donate a portion of her collection to students at Shepherd High School in hopes of motivating them to pursue a love of art as his wife did.

Raised in Shepherd, Marla was heavily involved in community activities and with Shepherd Public Schools, where both of her parents taught. In 2017, Chester created the Brattin Memorial Art Fund as a way to memorialize Marla and her parents, Harry and Jeannette Brattin. The fund will support art preservation and programming at Shepherd Public Schools.

The Hunter Family Fund is a donor advised fund that was created by Cheryl, John, and James Hunter in 2017 to support the efforts of local organizations within Isabella County.

Cheryl and David Hunter have lived in Mt. Pleasant since 1974. Their children were born and raised here. David loved attending all of his children's and grandchildren's sports and enjoyed watching them whether it be on the collegiate level or little league. Pleasant, Michigan.

When David passed away suddenly on November 21, 2017, Cheryl and family wanted to honor both David and their ties to the Mt. Pleasant area. Cheryl believes it is important for the community to have funds that can be utilized for different areas of concern such as education, literacy, and bettering our community.

# *Konwinski Construction Scholarship Fund*

Konwinski Construction was founded in 1977 by Jerel Konwinski, and has focused on residential and commercial construction around Isabella and Gratiot Counties. Mr. Konwinski recently sold the company to longtime employees Joe Fleming, Ben Humphrey and Andy Theisen Jr.



Konwinski Construction does their marketing primarily through word of mouth and by supporting and sponsoring community events, endeavors, and helping Isabella County graduates gain scholarships for college. As part of his business legacy, Mr. Konwinski

established the Konwinski Construction Scholarship Fund at the Community Foundation in 2018 to support students who have an interest in skilled trades, including, but not limited to: architecture, carpentry, civil engineering, construction management, electrician, HVAC/refrigeration technology, interior design, masonry, or

plumbing. The new fund will focus on students with financial need and minimum 2.5 GPA.

The new owners want to honor and continue Konwinski's legacy. "We hope more students come to realize that skilled trades are a viable option for future careers and a great way to make a living here in our community," said co-owner Joe Fleming. "Konwinski Construction wants to encourage students to pursue their passions within the trades in order to get a feel for the construction industry," Fleming added.

## *Carol Huber Konwinski and Jerel Konwinski Scholarship Fund*

Longtime supporters of Sacred Heart Parish and the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation, Carol and Jerel Konwinski decided to support both organizations in 2018, as part of their legacy to the Mt. Pleasant community. "The good Lord has blessed us, and we want to give back to our community," said Jerel.

Carol and Jerel were married in 2000, and have been a part of the Mt. Pleasant community for years. Born and raised here in Isabella County, Carol graduated from Sacred Heart Academy in 1978 and she was a dedicated employee of Central Plumbing in Mt. Pleasant for 36 years. Jerel moved to the community in 1972, and founded Konwinski Construction in 1977; his daughter, Melissa, graduated from Sacred Heart Academy in 1992.

The couple reflected on a favorite quote: "A hundred years from now, it will not matter what my bank account was, the sort of house I lived in, or the kind of car I drove...but the world may be different because I was important in the life of a child."

The Carol Huber Konwinski and Jerel Konwinski Scholarship Fund will support graduates of Sacred Heart Academy as they pursue higher education at an accredited university or trade school. Preference will be shown to those who express financial need in a written essay.



# *James D. and Karen A. McConnell Family Scholarship Fund*



The James D. and Karen A. McConnell Family Scholarship Fund was created as a way to give scholarships to recent graduates from Clare, Gratiot, and Isabella counties that are pursuing a career in agriculture. James (Jim) and Karen McConnell are lifelong residents of Isabella County, where they continue to reside and operate McConnell Farm Supply along with their son Nick McConnell. Jim and Karen raised three children in the area (Wendy, Amanda, and Nicholas), all being former graduates of Sacred Heart Academy as well as Central Michigan University. Community support and involvement have always been long standing priorities with the family. For decades, they have supported local community events, activities, organizations, and clubs.

McConnell Farm Supply was founded by Jim and Karen in 1971.

They built its foundation on supporting primarily dairy and livestock operators in the State of Michigan, as well as row crop farmers, contractors, landscapers, and others that may have a need for their sales, services, or parts departments. Along with supporting local area producers, the company also sends equipment across North America and throughout other regions of the world. A lifelong goal for Jim and Karen has been to give back to the community, particularly via supporting local young adults. The establishment of the endowed scholarship fund through the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation assures a sustained period of giving back, thus creating a legacy of their support for the young people who pursue their careers and their dreams.

## *Shepherd Football Scholarship Fund*

Shepherd Youth Football is a charitable organization founded in 2014 to further the development of leadership, character, sportsmanship, tolerance, discipline, and athletic ability; to nurture youth fitness, volunteerism, and a lifelong love of sports; and to serve as the feeder system to the Shepherd High School Bluejay's football program.



In selecting the most qualified applicant to receive the scholarship each year, reviewers will give preference to those who participated in Shepherd Youth Football, received the Warrior and/or Iron Man Award, have distinguished achievement in football and have demonstrated financial need.

In the fall of 2017, Shepherd Youth Football chose to begin an endowed scholarship fund that will support Shepherd High School graduates who have participated in football.

The Board of Shepherd Youth Football presented a symbolic check to start the scholarship fund during the high school's last home football game in October, 2017. The fund is currently growing and will award scholarships in the future.

## *Tumbl Trak Fund for Youth Fitness in Honor of Doug Davis and Diana Hughes*

Living in the Mt. Pleasant area in the late 80's, Doug Davis owned a gymnastics gym and taught area kids the importance of fitness while Diana Hughes was a professor of speech pathology at Central Michigan University that had a passion of being healthy and living a healthy lifestyle. Tumbl Trak was founded by Doug and Diana in Mt. Pleasant in 1988. Tumbl Trak creates innovative mats, bars, beams and other training aids for gymnastics, cheerleading, dance and martial arts.



Over the years, Tumbl Trak has built a strong company and reputation that only continues to grow. As both Doug and Diana lived locally, CEO of Tumbl Trak, Stacy Finnerty said that it "only made sense" for the headquarters to be located in Mt. Pleasant off of M-20. Today, the gym also has an office in Port Townsend, WA, where Doug and Diana now reside, as well as a distribution center in the United Kingdom. To honor their company founders, Tumbl Trak and its employees decided in 2017 to create an endowment fund that would serve as a legacy for Doug and Diana to provide grants to charitable organizations that will enable underprivileged youth to participate in healthy living and fitness programming.

## *Shamrock Invitational Fund*

Forty-one years ago, the Michael Sweeney Memorial Golf Tournament began for the benefit of the American Heart Association in Mecosta County. After several years, it was renamed the Shamrock Invitational Golf Outing, which honored Michael Sweeney's Irish heritage. During the 41 year tradition, the seven person board of the charitable event started an endowment fund with Mecosta County Community Foundation. This was done to assure their longstanding cycle of giving back to the community and providing scholarships for high school seniors from Big Rapids, Chippewa Hills, Crossroads Charter Academy, Lakeview, and Morley Stanwood.



to further their connections for a multitude of reasons. Brian Rush, board member, also serves on the Community Foundation's Board of Trustees. He introduced the idea of starting an endowment fund for Isabella County to board members Kyle White and Tom Tacia.

While guests do have to be invited, Tacia said participants tend to be age 45 or younger, and have a passion for charitable giving. White said the plan is to have the Invitational in Mecosta County one year, Isabella County the next, and repeating from then on. Bucks Run will serve as the venue for the upcoming 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Shamrock Invitational on July 17, 2019.

In 2016, the Shamrock Invitational board wanted to branch out into Isabella County and created a similar endowment fund at the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation. Board members of the Shamrock Invitational thought that Isabella County was the most fitting place



# *Michael and Dianne Morey Manufacturing Skilled Trades Scholarship Fund*

The Michael and Dianne Morey Manufacturing Skilled Trades Scholarship Fund was established in 2017 to provide scholarships to Isabella County students pursuing higher education and, ultimately, a career in manufacturing. The fund was started by Dianne Morey in memory of her mother and grandmother.

When asked about what prompted Dianne to start the fund, she said that she wanted to do something good with the money she inherited from her family. Dianne also stated that she and her husband, Mike, wanted to express to teachers that not every student is college bound, and that the manufacturing companies in our area have an importance that is sometimes overlooked. For example, when Michael and Dianne Morey started Bandit Industries in 1983, they had only 6 employees. Today, they employ and support 460, and try to help their community with any good endeavors that they can.

The first scholarship from this fund was awarded in the spring of 2018. When Dianne met the fund's first recipient, she said that she and her husband were so encouraged to see his enthusiasm, that they knew he was going to take every advantage he was given and push it to the max; it gives them both hope that the next generation will continue to put to good use any help that they are given.



## *Central Michigan Veterans Endowment Fund*

Though it was difficult operating with a small volunteer force, five local veterans came together to form the Central Michigan Veterans Fund (CMVF). The founders are Patrick Birgy, William Cain, Terry Kunst, Brian Rush, and Nick Cononico Jr., from the Vietnam, Desert Storm, Iraq and Afghanistan wars.



Since CMVF's inception in 2010, the charitable organization has provided scholarships for veterans and their dependents in the Mid-Michigan area who have served during the global war on terrorism. The organization funds educational and awareness programs, as well as funding campaigns

in the Mid-Michigan area on issues that pertain to the difficulties of re-integration back into civilian life. The organization also hosts an annual golf outing on the Saturday before the September 11<sup>th</sup> anniversary. They have provided 95 scholarships totaling over \$65,000 to students at Mid-Michigan Community College and Central Michigan University, area high school dependents of veterans, and currently serving military personnel within their service areas of Clare, Gratiot, Isabella and Mecosta Counties.



In December of 2017, the organization decided to place some of the proceeds from their most recent golf outing into an endowment fund that will continue to grow. The donor advised fund will support the efforts of organizations in Isabella County that serve military veterans. The Directors of the Central Michigan Veterans Fund shall serve as the advisors to the endowment fund.
