YOUR GIFT EARNS A SPECIAL TAX CREDIT

The state of Michigan encourages gifts to permanent endowments of community foundations. The state allows a 50% direct Michigan Income Tax Credit or Michigan Single Business Tax Credit subject to a maximum of:

- o \$100 credit for an individual who is single, or married and filing separately (for a gift of \$200).
- o \$200 credit for a married couple filing jointly (for a gift of \$400)
- o \$5,000 or 10% of the tax liability before any credits (whichever is less) for businesses filing Single Business Income Tax Returns.

After receiving both the Michigan and federal tax benefits, a \$400 gift from a married couple may cost as little as \$60 (35% tax rate).

Examples of the tax benefits:

Amount of Gift	Individual	Married	Corporation
	\$200	\$400	\$10,000
State Tax Credit	\$100	\$200	\$5,000
Federal Tax Rate	29%	25%	34%
Federal Tax Savings	\$58	\$100	\$3,400
Total Tax Savings	\$158	\$300	\$6,700
Actual Cost of Gift	\$42	\$100	\$3,300

All funds are owned and managed by the Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation. All gifts will be invested and the investment income will be distributed per the fund agreements and in accordance with the Foundation's spending policy. The Mt. Pleasant Area Community Foundation maintains explicit authority to redirect earnings of any fund if distributions of said fund become unnecessary, impossible to fulfill or inconsistent with the needs of the community.
